Canterbury Win 7 Gold's and 1 Silver at the South Island Junior Age Groups Teams Event



There was plenty of excitement and laughter around as 24 Canterbury juniors settled into the lodge at Ashburton Holiday Park on the evening of the Friday 20th September. The lodge seemed to be brand new and having a huge kitchen and lounge area we all felt Squash Canterbury had done us proud with accommodation.



Saturday dawned bright and sunny, which was to be the theme for the rest of the day. The kids were keen to see the courts, have a warmup and size up the other teams before play got underway against Midlands, Southland and Otago. The Canterbury results from the two rounds of play on Saturday were very strong, with only five matches lost and most of our age groups winning all three matches. By the close of play Saturday, Canterbury had all but won 5 of the 8 round robins, but the GU13, GU11 and BU17 still had a lot of work to do.

The GU11 had won all their Saturday matches, but their Sunday opponents Midlands B (a team of boys filling in for a Southland gap) had also won most of their Saturday matches, so it was game on for Sunday.

The GU13 situation was similar except that their Southland opponents for the Sunday had also picked up six wins on the Saturday so the Sunday was set for a classic showdown among traditional rivals in the women's game.

The BU17 had been well beaten by Southland on Saturday and with the Southland boys dominant, Canterbury Vs Midlands was to be effectively a play off for second and third.

On Saturday night Ashburton put on a pizza dinner and quiz night at the club which was well appreciated before wrangling the kids toward bedtime after a big day for everyone.



Sunday first up was the featured GU13 match. Grace Rhodes led off strongly with a well competed 3-0 win. Carly Craig had an excellent matchup but proved too strong in a close 3-1 win. Saya Stratton was then playing for a Canterbury clean sweep had another competitive match winning 13/11, 11/5, 11/6.

The GU11 match was all about bragging rights as the Midlands team of boys were not being counted toward the overall results, but fresh from success on Saturday the Canterbury girls were determined to do well. Lucy WiRepa started

The winners of our awards are presented with trophies at our Annual Awards, which will take place. An Award will be presented to the winner at the Squash Canterbury Awards from 2pm on Saturday 2nd November at the Sudima Hotel, Christchurch Airport.

Nominations are currently open for the following awards and close 9am on Monday 14th October (2 weeks away);

The Phil Morgan Trophy for Referee of the Year:

The Phil Morgan Trophy is presented annually to someone who has provided outstanding services to refereeing

New Coach of the Year: This award is for a coach who has been coaching for 2 years or less at any level.

Club and School Coach of the Year: This award is for a coach who works with junior or senior athletes in a club or school setting (this could include coaching individuals, junior programs, beginner coaching, schools coaching and graded teams).

The Foundation Cup for Volunteer of the Year: Squash in Canterbury would struggle to exist if it wasn't for all the volunteers that are the lifeblood of Squash with the district. The volunteers make our sport happen in the community and are vital to the development of the game. The Volunteer of the Year award rewards outstanding contribution from a volunteer to the sport of squash within Canterbury.

Club of the Year: Clubs play an important role in society. They draw people together; they help to knit communities and they provide a place where people can enjoy themselves both on and off the squash courts. The Club of the Year award recognizes clubs for their valuable contribution and achievement in the delivery of community squash.

Service to Squash: The Squash Canterbury Service to Squash award recognizes the services volunteers play at a club level. Each club can nominate one volunteer who deserves to be recognized for their efforts at the Squash Club. This should be someone who has not been nominated before

Koru Games is a multi-sport tournament for year 7 & 8 children at South Island schools. The 2019 games took place across the Selwyn District 17th – 19th September.



The focus of the games is on individual skill development and sports adapt their competition formats to support this. Many of the players in the squash competition were new to squash and giving it a go. It was great to see how much the players developed and strengthened their game over the 3 days of competition.

The girls' competition saw great improvement in each player's game, especially the girls entered from Burnham School. A very exciting play off for 3rd & 4th position saw each team win 1 match, and for the only time during the tournament each team also scored the same points Burnham 1 33 to 37 Burnham 2 and 38 / 34 so a 71/71 tie awarding a Bronze tie for 3rd place well done girls every point counts.

1st & 2nd play off was a repeat of the girls' final from 2018 with St Martins School v Middleton Grange playing off. St Martins proving too strong winning 40/28 and 40/13, who will be in the final next year!

The boys' competition was very competitive, clearly many of the boys had encouraged their parents to provide an opportunity for pre-games training and the players were rewarded with some great games.

3rd & 4th play off was between Ladbrook's & Lemonwood Schools. Ladbrook's won the first game 40/33, number 1 from Ladbrook's Jack Macdonald fighting on after a foot injury doing well to win 27 points against a strong Lemonwood opponent final score 27/40 with Lemonwood winning on points count back 73/67.

1st & 2nd play off was against a strong Ashburton Intermediate team and a developing team from Broadfield school who gave it their all with every point. Ashburton winning 38/32 and 40/32 anyone watching this thrilling final would never have known the team from Broadfield only started training 6 weeks ago.
